## THE CHALLENGE

Developing an effective strategy will involve acquiring an understanding of :-

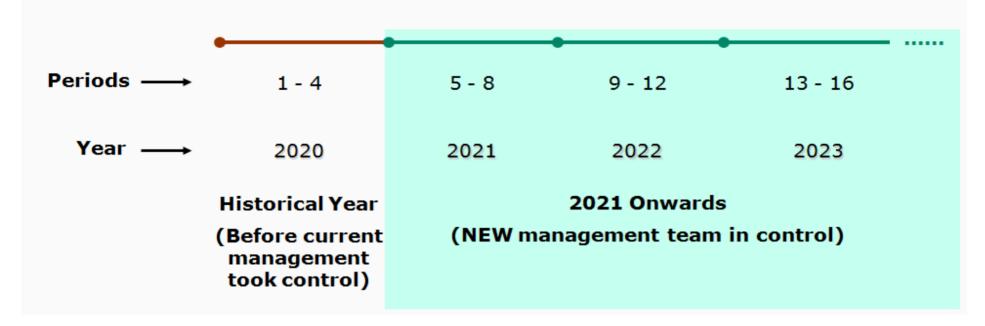
- The economic environment in which the company is operating

## THE EARLY YEARS (PERIODS 5-12)

During the Early Years the competition for jobs comes from a number of simulated companies. Each one has their own unique profile and bidding history, and a careful assessment of the opposition is required to formulate an effective procurement strategy.

## THE LATER YEARS (PERIODS 13-18)

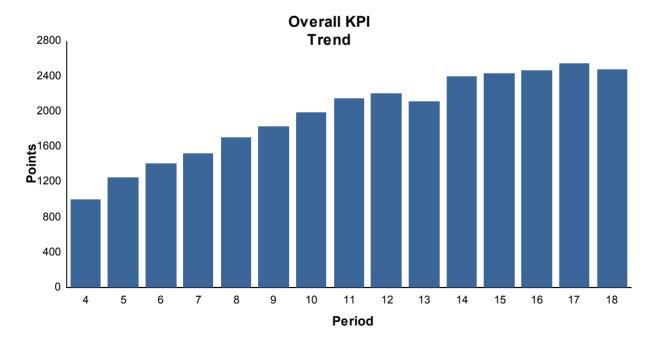
During the Later Years the teams compete 'head to head' against each other for work. This creates an even more uncertain and pressurized environment in which the skills and team dynamics formed in the early years are really put to the test.

## **OVERALL PERFORMANCE (KPIs)**

Performance Indicators were used to measure company progress, weighted at the end of the History to reflect their variability, initially to 1,000 points.

A measure of how profitable the company is after considering all operating factors

#### COMPANY VALUE

A measure of the asset value of the company

#### CAPITAL EMPLOYED

A measure of how well the company's infrastructure is being utilised

#### CONTRACT COMPLETION

An indication of how successful the company is in completing contracts

#### FORWARD WORKLOAD

The remaining turnover (value) of jobs still in progress

#### FORWARD MARGIN

The remaining profit of jobs still in progress

#### SHARE PRICE

A measure of the strength of the company's share price

#### CLIENT SATISFACTION

An indication of the strength of the relationship build up with the company's clients
